NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN ON SPACES CANCELLED WITHIN 10 DAYS OF SHOW DATE. **No table "Roll Overs" after 20 days prior to show date.** ALL UNCLAIMED SPACES WILL REVERT BACK TO D.A.C.A. AT 10 AM ON SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 26. **I agree to maintain my trade space at the Dallas Gun and Knife Show as rented until 4 pm on the last day of the show and should I choose to vacate the show early, I am subject to non-renewal of any and all future trade spaces and forfeiture of any related funds.** PERSONAL CHECKS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED FOR RESERVATIONS WITHIN 30 DAYS OF THE SHOW DATE (MONEY ORDERS OR CASHIER'S CHECKS ONLY. NO CASH, PLEASE). Your paid reservation will be acknowledged by return mail.

Exhibitor table renewal: You may renew tables from 1 pm-6:30 pm Friday, 7:30 am - 4 pm Saturday and 8 am - 3 pm Sunday. **You must renew tables by 4 pm Saturday to ensure same tables for next show.**

D.A.C.A. SHOW STANDARDS

Each and every table in the main hall must qualify under the 85% acceptable item “arms or arms related” rule. The main hall is the area with the high ceiling.

1. **Items banned from sale** include cameras (still, phone or video), black powder, black jacks, brass knuckles, throwing stars, nun chucks, toys of any kind, collector cards, jewelry, items displaying vulgarity, obscenity, or death of animals or persons, lock picks and books on how to make bombs or illegal guns. *With prior permission from DACA Gun Show Chairperson, photos of displays may be taken for publicity or advertising purposes.*
2. Sound (noise) demonstrations of items for sale are not allowed. This includes stun gun demos.
3. Arms or arms related items are defined as guns, gun parts, books about guns, military history, gun cleaning supplies, tools designed for gunsmithing, ammunition in sealed containers, reloading supplies and equipment, edged weapons (for hunting and outdoor use), hunting supplies, military surplus, taxidermy products and western heritage items (collectable spurs, bits, leather items, saddles, blankets, etc.) (85% of each space) items permitted on the remaining 15% (approximately 3 square feet) on each table are fishing supplies, current production clothing, sunglasses, radios, boots, handmade arts and crafts, belts, buckles, tools, paintings, prints and photos.
4. All handguns on dealer’s spaces must be secured by cord or alarm cable or within glass cases to help resist theft during the show.
5. **All decisions of the DACA Show Chairman, DACA Officers or Board as to the acceptability of all items offered for sale or display will be final.** First offense results in a warning and the banned or inappropriate items being removed from display. The second offense of displaying banned or inappropriate items will result in the vendor being removed from the show and forfeiture of rental fees.
6. The bottom of all hanging signs and banners must be at least 6’8” above the floor and the top of any sign may be no higher than 11’ above the floor.
7. **All local, state and federal laws must be observed.**
8. The original purchaser of the show space is responsible to register the space. The original purchaser will forfeit all sublet space found not in compliance with show standards. The person who sublet the space will be removed from the show. Recurring instances of violations will result in the original purchaser being banned from the show and losing the privilege of renting space for a 12 month period from the date the sublet space was found to be in noncompliance.
9. Alcoholic beverages will not be consumed in Market Hall during show hours.
10. Absolutely no animals are allowed in Market Hall other than service dogs.
11. **Vendor badges are not to be given or sold to customers or any other non-vendors. Zero tolerance.**

AMMUNITION SALES IN MARKET HALL

To comply with restrictions of Dallas Market Center and our liability insurance company, all ammunition in the show must be sealed or secured in the following manner:

At the front door:

1. Any ammunition in a gun, clip or magazine when it comes in the front door goes into the “ammo jug.” Law enforcement officers, with proper ID displayed, are the only exception.
2. Ammunition, in modern boxes, must be taped at both ends.
3. Vintage or collectable ammunition must be sealed in a Zip-Loc type bag and either taped or stapled.

On the tables:

1. Boxed ammo must be taped or sealed at both ends (either by the factory or the vendor).
2. Ammunition in plastic bags must be taped, heat sealed, or stapled.
3. Ammunition in ammo cans must be covered with plastic and that plastic must be secured to the side of the can with tape, so that the rounds inside cannot be easily removed.
4. Vintage or collectable ammunition must be in sealed plastic bag or in a locked glass case. Ammo sold from locked glass cases must be put into sealed plastic bags at the point of sale.

Failure to meet and comply with show standards as described herein will be grounds for removal from the show with no refund.
